CUSTOMS ACT 1901

INTENTION TO REVOKE TARIFF CONCESSION ORDERS

The Comptroller-General of Customs intends to revoke the Tariff Concession Order (TCO) for the goods described in the following TABLE in accordance with s.269SD(1AA) with effect from 24 August 2016.

On 24 August 2016, the Comptroller-General of Customs' delegate formed the belief in respect of this TCO, that if the TCO was not in force on that day, and an application for the TCO was made on that day, the Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made it. The Comptroller-General of Customs would not have made this TCO because he believes that the wording does not give a full description of the goods the subject of the TCO.

Interested parties who might be affected by this decision are invited to provide, by close of business 21 September 2016, a written submission concerning the proposed revocation.
