NOTICE OF DETERMINATIONS MADE UNDER PART XVI OF THE CUSTOMS ACT 1901

Under subsection 273B(2) of the Customs Act 1901, notice is hereby given of the making of determinations applying to goods of a kind specified in the table below.

In the table

Goods ancillary to an EPBS project, including office equipment, buildings, office/personnel accommodation and goods used in activities such as land preparation, road construction and maintenance, transportation (other than pipes, pipelines, conveyors, power transmission lines, flexible flow lines, etc integral to the project and used to convey gas liquids, minerals, electricity or other materials or goods) and the provision of telecommunications and other general services are excluded. Materials, consumables and construction and servicing equipment, including all fuels, oils lubricants, adhesives, filters, protective garments, tools, ladders (other than articles auxiliary to and designed to be permanently attached to eligible goods under EPBS, such as pylons, supporting structures, staircases, ladders, railings, etc) paint, varnish and the like are ineligible under EPBS, as are spare parts used for on-going maintenance beyond the commissioning of the project.

EPBS determinations also apply to all goods listed in the determination when they are imported in multiple shipments, which may be from different locations at different times.

SCHEDULE 4

BY-LAW No. 1700051

I, Andrew Chandler, delegate of the Comptroller-General of Customs, for the purposes of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901, make the by-law set out in the Schedule below.

In the by-law set out in the Schedule below, "security" means security required from the importer to the satisfaction of the Collector under section 42 of the Customs Act 1901.

THE SCHEDULE

- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 1700051.
- 2. This by-law shall take effect on and from 1 January 2017.
- 3. For the purposes of item 38 of Schedule 4 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* the following goods, subject to paragraphs 4, 5 and 6, are prescribed.
 - (a) vehicle components for use as original equipment in the manufacture or assembly of the cab/chassis or drivable chassis of a particular motor vehicle, having a g.v.w. exceeding 3.5 tonnes, which, if imported, would be classified under a heading or subheading of Schedule 3 specified in Table 1 below:

UNDER SECURITY.

- For the purposes of this by-law, "use" includes used up, (e.g. damaged or destroyed) provided that the Collector is satisfied that the particular goods would not be suitable for use as motor vehicle components.
- This by-law does not apply to the following: 5.
 - sub-assemblies incorporating a combination of more than one of the following:
 - (i) cabs:
 - (ii) chassis frames;
 - (iii) clutches;
 - (iv) engines;

 - (v) gearboxes;
 (vi) propeller shaft assemblies;
 - (vii) radiators; or
 - (viii) suspension systems; or
 - goods, as follows: (b)
 - cabs other than bare cabs; or (i)
 - (ii) chassis frames fitted with any attachment or component other than mounting brackets or towing hooks; or
 - goods, as follows: (C)
 - (i) accumulators (batteries) or parts therefor;(ii) air-brake equipment or parts therefor;

 - (iii) brake drums (other than transmission brake drums) or parts therefor;
 - (iv) cab seats or parts therefor;
 - hubs (other than geared hubs) or parts therefor; (V)
 - (vi) propeller shaft assemblies or parts therefor;
 - (vii) radiators or parts therefor;
 - (viii) radiator hoses;
 - (ix) radiator flexible mountings;
 - radios or magnetic sound reproducers whether combined or not, or parts therefor; (x)
 - (xi) steering gearboxes or parts therefor;
 - (xii) suspension components or parts therefor;
 - (xiii) tapered roller bearings;
 - (xiv) tubes (inner);
 - (xv) tyres;
 - (xvi) valves for tubeless tyres; or
 - wheels or parts therefor.
- For the purposes of this by-law: 6.
 - "air-brake equipment" means equipment clearly identified as being directly concerned with the braking function and includes foot brake valves, air valves, air tanks, brake chambers, airlines and fittings but does not include engine integrated air compressors, warning devices, axle incorporated components being brake drums, shoes or linings, slack adjusters, cam shafts or brake foundations, or airline and fittings clearly identified as components for use with peripheral air operated activities such as door closure;
 - "bare cabs" means cabs not painted further than prime coated and not fitted or trimmed with any (b) componentry (e.g. seats, instruments, window glass, rubber trim, etc.) other than mounting brackets:
 - "brake drums" includes brake drums machined or unmachined; (c)
 - "cab seats" includes all seats in crew cab or dual cab vehicles and the driver's seat in buses;
 - (e) "clutches" means transmission clutches (i.e. main driveline equipment);
 - "engine" does not include goods incorporating any transmission equipment (i.e. main driveline (f) equipment);
 - "gearboxes" means transmission gearboxes (i.e. main driveline equipment); (q)
 - "propeller shaft assemblies" means main driveline equipment; (h)
 - "radiators" means a sub-assembly comprising water tanks with inlet and outlet manifolds, radiator (i) core and integral frame;

- (j) "suspension components" means components identified as being concerned with the suspension function being spring hangers, spring saddles, equaliser beams, walking beams, shock absorbers or mounting brackets other than chassis mounting brackets;
- (k) "g.v.w." (gross vehicle weight) is the road weight specified by the manufacturer as being the maximum design weight capacity of the vehicle. This weight is the combined weight of the vehicle, the maximum specified load, the driver and a tank full of fuel.
- 7. For the purposes of this by-law, the "Customs Tariff Act 1995" means the Customs Tariff Act 1995, as amended or proposed to be altered.

SCHEDULE 4

BY-LAW No. 1700052

I, Andrew Chandler, delegate of the Comptroller-General of Customs, under section 271 of the *Customs Act 1901* make the by-law set out in the Schedule below.

In the by-law set out below, "security" means the security given (under section 42 of the $Customs\ Act\ 1901$) to, and to the satisfaction of, the Collector by the importer.

THE SCHEDULE

Item 48 Schedule 4

- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 1700052.
- 2. This by-law shall take effect on and from 1 January 2017.
- 3. For the purposes of item 48 of Schedule 4 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, uncompounded polyamides and polyesters classified under subheadings 3907.6, 3907.70.00, 3907.9 or heading 3908 in Schedule 3 to the *Customs Tariff Act 1995* are prescribed.
- 4. The application of item 48 to the goods in paragraph 3 is subject to the condition that the goods are for use in the manufacture of fibres or yarns, UNDER SECURITY.
- 5. For the purposes of this by-law, the "Customs Tariff Act 1995" means the Customs Tariff Act 1995, as amended or proposed to be altered.
