Recent changes to the DIBP website allow improved search capability for Tariff Concession Orders. This can be found via the Domestic Manufacturers page on the Website at:

A search engine specifically able to search via words has been installed to the website. The additional capability allows users to search for existing TCOs by either their tariff classification or **specific word/s**. The improved capability to search by word will assist users not fully acquainted with tariff classifications provided by the Harmonised System. Examples attached.
