Benefits to the Applicant
 Duty deferral to be introduced in 2017/2018
 Fast tracked clearance of goods
Reduced intervention in the supply chain process
 Periodic lodgment of entries
Top of pile processing for Tariff Advices/TCOs etc
 Allocated DIBP Account Manager for all DIBP related issues
**Assembly orders able to be lodged with a single entry (to be confirmed)
**Exemption from paying IPC (Import Processing Charges) – (to be confirmed)

Process
Pre EOI discussion to confirm eligibility and benefits, and green light to proceed
Lodge EOI
Set dates for Gap Analysis
Meeting with DIBP ATT administrators (if required)
Gap Analysis & SAQ Preparation
List of areas requiring further work identified and completed
SAQ finalized
SAQ lodged when portal opens
Audit conducted by DIBP ATT staff
ATT status conferred

 Considerations
 Gap Analysis costs
Time required to prepare SAQ, revise documentation & processes – allow several weeks
Benefits may take some time to come online
If application delayed until benefits come online it may take a year to reap benefits resulting in considerable opportunity costs
ATT process may generate operational improvements or increased professionalism
