## EUROPEAN PORT CONGESTION CAUSING MAJOR DELAYS

mporters continue to face serious delays due to ongoing congestion and supply chain disruption across key North European ports — and the situation isn't likely to ease anytime soon. While there has been a slight improvement in recent weeks, it appears to be only temporary.

Major ports including Hamburg, Rotterdam, Antwerp and Bremerhaven are under significant pressure, with yard utilisation exceeding 90%. A mix of labour shortages, infrastructure constraints and weather-related setbacks are further compounding the strain.

Hamburg is a particular hotspot, with rail access scheduled to shut down completely from 4th to 8th July. This closure is expected to delay up to 20,000 TEU as containers normally moved by rail will need to be shifted to already stretched trucking services. Meanwhile, strikes, tighter container pick-up windows and reduced barge availability are worsening delays in Rotterdam and Antwerp. Carriers are reacting by shortening port calls and making last-minute changes to vessel schedules, creating additional uncertainty for shipments. Transit times from North Europe are now stretching out to 55-70 days, with some delays blowing out to as much as 90 days. The ripple effects are also being felt further, with container flows from the UK, China, and North America impacted as global networks adjust to the congestion.
